

- Click Setup under Marketing API here
- Then go to Settings -> Basic > copy both App ID and App Secret and paste into blink accordingly.




2- Select User Access Token in User or Page dropdown

3- Click Other & select Catalogue Management from the dropdown and click Generate Access Token.


Debug

c- Copy newly created token and paste it in Blink Vendor Portal on Facebook Token Field and select current date in Token Generated At field.

Now, paste the newly created token into blink.

NOTE: Also debug newly created token and then check Expires in about 2 months (Follow step A)

Once all the information is filled into the blink, click
Save Changes


